The Department of Education has released the State of New Jersey's PARCC scores. A few things to note are;

- The following tables represent scores for the entire State of New Jersey
- The scores will start a baseline for upcoming school years.
- The upcoming School Report Cards will not include performance targets based on this data.
- District, school and individual student scores will be released in the next two months (Nov. or Dec.).
- These results are a piece of the multiple measures that we use to determine student growth. GMRSD takes into account several factors depending on grade level. This may include, but is not limited to, multiple benchmark assessments, student grades, Diagnostic Reading Assessments, Edmentum (MS)
- The actual scoring range on these assessments is very different from the NJASK. The ASK scores have been archived by the Department of Education and should not be used for comparison with the PARCC.
